Annual Regular Collection of Basic Higher Education Data

 The Office of Policy, Planning, Research and Information (UPPRI) of the Commission on Higher Education (CHEU) shall collect hasic higher education data from all higher education institutions (HEIs) nationable for school year 1974-1975. the last week of May. The OFPRI shall process the forms and produce the data bullstins in the first week of July 1995.

4. Heads of government and private higher education institutions are held responsible for the prompt, complete and accurate filling up of the data gathering forms and the timely submission of the same.

The CHED Regional Directors shall implement rigid data control and verification procedures on the accomplished forms to ensure complete, accurate and reliable data,
