In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act [RA] No. 7722, otherwise known as the "ligher Education Act of 1994," and by virtue? Resolution No. 001, Series of 1995, of the Commission en banc, all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are hereby enjoined to spearhead activities to celebrate the Centennial Year of the late President Carlos P. Garcia in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 728. The following activities may be undertaken; namely:

- Restructuring of the physical and social environment of the HEls on the first week of November 1996 and setting the bulletin boards and rooms with exhibits of the late President Carlos P. Garcia as an eminent legislator, and the control of the Philippines;
   Statesman of the Republic of the Philippines;
- Reprinting of the CPG story by Bernardo R. Calibo for dissemination to students to enable them to gain a better understanding of President Garcia's leadership; and

- 3.1 The host HEIs of these lecture-series are given full authority to undertake the activity in coordination with the Commission's HEROs.
- 3.2 Payment for honoraria and expenses for transportation and accommodation of lecturer, as well as expenses for the exhibits, venue, press conference and other incidental expenses shall be shouldered by the Commission where applicable. Travel expenses of representatives from CPG Executive Committee, HEIROS, HEIIs, and other private entities shall be charged against local funds.

All HEROs shall monitor the conduct of the aforementioned activities in their respective areas of jurisdiction.
