SUBJECT: GO-NGO ACADEME NATIONAL CONSULTATION WORKSHOP ON HUMAN RIGHTS EDUCATION

Regions Covered

In accordance with pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and by the vitrue of Resolution No. 001, Series of 1995, of the Commission en bane, all Presidents/Heads of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and CHED Regional Directors are hereby informed and directed, thus:

 The Commission on Higher Education (CHED); the Commission on Human Rights (CHR); the Department of Education, Culture, and Sports (DECS); and Amnesty International Pilipinas (AIP) will collaborately conduct a National Consultative Workshop on Human Rights Education on the following dates and venues:

Cluster I	IX, X, XI, XII and CARAGA	November 25-29, 1996	St. Paul Semmary Cagayan de Oro City
Cluster II	1, 11, 111, IV and CAR	November 11-15, 1996	NEAP, Baguio City

Cluster III V, VI, VII, VIII and November 18-22, 1996 ECOTECH Center NCR Cebu City

- 2. The consultation-workshop is aimed at a) formulating a common vision and mission on human rights education in the Philippines; b) developing a 10-year plan of action on human rights education in the observance of the UN Decade for Human Rights Education; c) documenting of human rights efforts/activities by agencies involved in human rights education.
- Participants in the workshops are CHED Regional Directors/Supervisors, and representatives of Higher Education Institutions involved in Human Rights Education. Participants are expected to be at the venues in the afternoon of Day 0.

4. The following registration fees, chargeable against local funds, shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, honoraria of resource persons and technical staff and other expenses:

Cluster II - P3,000.00 Cluster III - 4,000.00 Cluster III - 3,500.00

- 5. Transportation, per diem and other expenses relative to the attendance of participants to this activity may be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from private institutions may make their own financial arrangements with their respective institution.
- The subject undertaking is hereby officially endorsed by the Commission for the support and participation of all concerned.
