PARTICIPATION OF ALL HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN THE PHILIPPINE CENTENNIAL COMMEMORATIVE ACTIVITIES

X-----

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1954," and to stir interest amongst the youth and students in the Philippine Centennial Celebrations, all Higher Education Institutions (HEBs) are hereby enjoined to participate in the Centennial Commenorative activities to the most effective extent possible, thus:

1. National Flag Celebration

The 100° anniversary of the making of the Philippine Flag will be commemorated by the simultaneous hoisting of the Philippine flags all over the country on 28 May 1998 at 7:00 am. HEIs may conduct flag parades and other caivities focusing public awareness on the Philippine flag and what it symbolizes.

2. 100 Flags Parade

Parades of Philippine Flags will be held in 100 sites all over the country, including the 73 provincial capitols and 23 key cities. HEIs may coordinate with the Provincial Governors in their respective localities for participation details.

3. Singing of the Philippine Centennial Song

The Philippine Centennial Song may form part of the Flag Raising Ceremonies held every Monday. The Commission's Centennial Deck is exerting its best efforts to provide each HEI one audiocassette copy of the Philippine Centennial Song as produced by the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP).

4. Philippine Centennial Movement Drive

Local chapters of the Philippine Centeanial Movement may be established. Membership forms and related materials are now being distributed to all HEIs through the Commission's Higher Education Regional Offices (HEROs).

5. Use of the Centennial Logo on Official Stationeries

The Centennial Logo may be affixed on official stationeries to be used in 1998. HEIs may contact the CHED HEROs for further information.

6. Centennial Décor Competition

The Centennial Décor Competition will only cover Metropolitan Manila. All HIIs are geouraged to bring to the fore their best creative talents to express the best qualities of our people and focus public awareness on the significance of the Philippine Centennial.

7. Lakbay-Sining

The Lakbay-Sining is a national touring program of high-quality and original Philippine Centennial productions in dance, music, drama, literature and visual arts. The lead implementor is the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP). This program is designed to bring the Centennial Awareness campaign to the regions.
