SUBJECT: ADVISORY ON RECOGNITION OF STUDIES AND DEGREES IN GREECE

Pursuant to the Advisory letter of the Office of European Affairs, Department of Foreign Affairs all concerned are informed and directed thus:

- 1. The Coursel of State, the highest count of Greece decided against recognizing the degree obtained by students in beat humbes of private European universities. The decided of the Course of the
 - Filipino students are advised not to study in any of the branches of foreign universities in Greece. Furthermore, graduates of the private foreign universities in Greece are no longer allowed to practice their profession due to the aforementioned ruling.
 - It is requested that this circular be widely disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
