CHED MEMORANDUM ORDER (CMO)

SUBJECT : COLLEGIATE CALENDAR FOR

ACADEMIC YEAR (AY) 2000 - 2001

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1984," the Calendar for Academic Year (AY) 2000 – 2001 for the collegiate level is hereby promulgated, thus:

- A. As a general rule, the opening of classes for all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) for AY 2000-2001 shall not be earlier than the first Monday of June 2000 nor later than the 4th Monday of the same month.
- B. Specifically, the following dates and periods shall apply, to wit:
- 1) The collegiste calendar for AY 2000-2001 will begin on Monday, 5 June 2000, and will end on 10 March 2001. Collegiste school days shall consist of not less than eighteen (8) weeks per semester and six (6) weeks for summer classes, excluding Christmas, semestral and summer breaks. The said school days shall include examination days and class days which may be suscended due to natural or man-made causer.
 - The first semester will start on 5 June 2000 and will end on 7 October 2000:
 - The second semester will start on 23 October 2000 and will end on 10 March 2001; and
 - c. Summer classes will start on 2 April 2001 and will end on 12 May 2001.
- The Christmas break will begin on 18 December 2000 and will end on 1 January 2001.
- C. In addition to the regular and special public holidays recognized by law (Sections 26 and 21, Chapter 7, Administrative Code of 1987), HEIs may observe school holidays, provided that the minimum collegiate school days within a semester or summer stated in B.1 hereof are strictly followed and provided, furthermore, that the minimum length of actual student contact time of seventeen (17) hours, inclusive of examinations, shall be observed for every one-unit collegiate academic credit.

- D. HEIs, including those offering graduate degree programs, adopting the trimestral system may establish their own school calendars and opening days provided however, that the concerned Higher Education Regional Office (HERO) is properly informed of their particular schedules, and provided further that the minimum number of class hours and class days requirement herein set forth are met.
- E. HEIs using atternative instruction delivery modes may establish their own school calendar and opening days provided however, that the concerned Higher Education Regional Office is properly informed of their particular schedules and delivery schemes and/or motules, provided finither, that such programs to be officed including delivery schemes have prior approval of the Commission on hanc.
- F. The Collegiate Calendar for AY 2000-2001 and the distribution of class days by weeks/months per semester and summer are hereby enclosed for the guidance of all concerned.
