FOR TEACHING STAFF FOR REGIONS IX, X, XI,  
XII AND CARAGA

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and in consonance with CHED Memorandum Order No. 41, s. 1998, in order to make higher education institutions responsive to the changing nature of education among them, a sequel to the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) training, held at the Bukidnon State College, Malaybalay, Bukidnon, on August 31-September 9, 1998, shall be held at the Applied Nutrition Center, Banilad, Cebu City, on November 13-21, 2000. Said training shall be conducted by the same British expert in collaboration with the British Council.

Participants to this training shall be the CPD Staff Developers who will take charge in the continuity of the training program.

The first batch of the CPD Staff Developers for Regions X, XI and CARAGA shall attend the first three (3) days of the training from November 13 to 15, 2000 as a refresher of the course. The second batch of the CPD Staff Developers from Regions IX, XI, XII and XIII and all Regional CPD Coordinators shall attend the complete 7-day training from November 15 to 21, 2000.

Transportation to and from the training site and registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) per participant shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Participants from the private sector shall make arrangements with their respective schools. Expenses for board and lodging and seminar materials will be borne by the Commission on Higher Education.

Regional Directors of the respective regions are enjoined to attend the training.
