The abovementioned institutions shall be subject to regular monitoring and assessment. If found not complying with or not maintaining the standards, they shall be delisted from the CHED list submitted to IMO.

However, one institution (Cotabato City Central College, Cotabato City) with substantial compliance under CMO No. 3, 4, 5 1999 whose programs - BSMT and BSMsrE were not visited due to the peace and order situation in Mindanae and circumstances beyond CHED's control. This institution shall be monitored and if found not complying with or not maintaining the standards shall be delisted from the CHED list submitted to Mindane.



All other maritime programs not listed in this order and CMO No. 8, s. 2001 shall be phased-out effective SY 2001-2002. Therefore, no first year students shall be allowed to enroll. Furthermore, currently enrolled students shall be assisted to transfer to other maritime institutions which are included in the said lists.

This Order is an addendum to CMO No. 8, series of 2001 - List of Maritime Institutions which have Fully Compiled with STCW '95 Requirements to Supersede the List under CMO No. 34, s. 1999.
