SUBJECT: ENCOURAGING THE OFFERING OF CHINESE
LANGUAGE AS PART OF THE
UNDERGRADUATE CURRICULA AND PH.D.

GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and following the announcement made by Her Excellency, President Gloria Mecapagal Arroyo in a speech delivered before the Flighino-Chinese Cammunity at the PICC Reception Hall, CCP Complex, Passay City, on June 8, 2001 as part of the 130" Philippine Governous and Complex Passay City, on June 8, 2001 as part of the 130" Philippine and contributions of the Filiphino-Chinese Community in the economic development and social well-being of the Filiphino people, the following policy statements are hereby Issued for the implementation of all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs), both overemment and revisars.

- In the undergraduate degree programs, all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are encouraged to offer Chinese language as part of the curricula in the various disciplines.
- In the Ph.D. graduate degree program, the offering of Chinese language as part of the foreign language requirement for a total of six (6) units is likewise encouraged.
