: CHED PRIORITY COURSES FOR AY 2003-2004

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 19194", and as a result of the interaigency meeting conducted with representatives from the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA), Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE), Philippine Association of State Universities and Colleges (PASUC), and Coordinating Council for Private Educational Associations (COCOPEA), the following are the identified priority courses for AV 2003-2004, where in-coming grantees of CHED-administered student financial assistance programs (STUFAPe), shall be directed to enroll:
