VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS THAT WILL SERVE AS SATELLITE VENUES FOR THE SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES FROM NOVEMBER 20 TO DECEMBER 5,2005

Pursuant to pertinent provisions of Republic Act 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and in the exigency of the service, Higher Education Institutions are hereby requested to suspend classes in cities and provinces that will serve as satellite venues for the Southeast Asian Games (SEA Games). Affected classes shall hold make up sessions in order to comply with the same number of contact hours in their respective subjects.

Dr. Puna:

This refers to Congressman Monico O. Puentevella's letter dated October 3, 2005. Congressman Puentevella requested that the Southeast Asian Games ("SEA Games") period be declared as a special holiday for schools in the provinces and cities that will serve as satellite venues for the events.

According to Cong. Puentevella, Bacolcd City is preparing for the staging of the biennial meet which will be held from November 20 to December 5, 2005. A number of the members of the organizing committee for the seld event are student volunteers from colleges and universities in the area. Hence, he is requesting for the suspension of classes during the SEA Games period to provide the student voluntaers more time and focus to prepare for the said event.

Republic Act No. ("R.A.") 7722 creating the Commission on Higher Education ("CHED") provides that the CHED shall govern both public and private institutions of higher education.\(^1\) Among the functions of the CHED is to formulate and recommend development plans, policies, priorities, and programs on higher education and research.\(^2\) Considering that the proposal may have adverse impact on the plans and program of the CHED, as well as the curriculum of the concerned institutions under your supervision, we are requesting for your comments and recommendation on the said request.
