GMA to keep mum on 2010 political plans

No amount of challenges, threats or constant urging from various personalities could force President Arroyo to reveal her political plans for 2010. Deputy presidential spokesperson Lorelei Fajardo said vesterday that the latest challenge coming from Chief Justice Revnato Puno would not do anything to alter the stand of the President to keep her plans from the public.
